
TIME, PLACE AND ATTENDANCE	The Moriarty City Council met at regular Council Meeting on January 28, 2026, with the following members present: Kim Garcia, Jeremy Trujillo, Kenny Snow and Robin Spalding
CALL TO ORDER	Mayor Anaya called the meeting to order at 6:30pm
AGENDA APPROVAL	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Councilor Snow, all in favor, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Public Comments	Jerri Pohl -stated that the city's website needs to be updated to include current minutes, meeting packets etc.
Consent Agenda	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the consent agenda, second by Councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Wastewater Update	Donzil Worthington with Bohanan Huston, updated the governing body on the City's wastewater and the issues. He pointed out some emergency repair issues and updated the council on what the PER entailed and what the grant money will be used for. Jeff also gave an update on the emergency repairs needed with the wastewater. He requested funding for the repairs for some manholes and to complete the line repair in the Tulane area. a. There are 2 estimates from TLC \$ 47151.56 for one manhole repairs noting that there are other manholes that need repairs and it might be more cost effective to do all of them at once and SpearD, Councilor Snow made a motion to approve the quote, second by Councilor Spalding, all present voted yes, motion carried. b. The other estimate in the amount of \$ 145,212.72 for the remaining repairs in the Tulane area, Councilor Snow made a motion to approve the quote , second by Councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Airport	Colonel Hudson gave an update on the airport and informed the governing body that he has received grants for a storage unit for his tractor and supplies. He is required to go through CES contracting on the grant. Councilor Trujillo made a motion to approve the expenditure of this grant(OEO-26-01) in the amount of \$ 362,418, second by Councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion carried.

Police Dept	In the absence of the Chief, the clerk Emily Sanchez presented the item for a one-time merit increase. The Dept. of Safety LERF will give the grant for the merit increase in the amount of \$ 3584.89, this is offered by DPS for officer retention. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the one-time merit increase, second by Councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion passed
Veterans Monument	Chief Hart presented governing body with a list of improvements needed at monument. Public Works, Jeff Tapia agreed that his department could do the work. Councilor Garcia made a motion to allow public works to complete the work needed at Veterans Monument, second by Councilor Spalding, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Fire Dept. Chief Hart	a. Requestion approval for the additional expense for helmets, the previous quote was expired, and the additional fees will be \$ 270.00 and will come out of line item 20-3002-57999. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the expenditure, second by Councilor Spalding, motion carried. b. State Forestry was on agenda for the civic center, but they found another venue to host their meeting. They no longer need this request
