
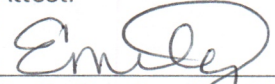




CITY OF MORIARTY
REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
March 11, 2026 7:30 P.M.

TIME, PLACE AND ATTENDANCE	The Moriarty City Council met at a Regular City Council Meeting on March 11, 2026, with the following members present: Mayor Steve Anaya, Robin Spalding, Kenny Snow, Kim Garcia and Jeremy Garcia
CALL TO ORDER	Mayor Steve Anaya called the meeting to order at 6:31p.m.
AGENDA APPROVAL	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the agenda with the following changes: remove the Special Meeting minutes and move item 3 from consent agenda to the regular meeting, second by Councilor Spalding, all present voted yes, motion passed.
MATTERS FROM GOVERNING BODY	Mayor Anaya gave an update on the Grissom park and cemetery work, work is moving along, there were some water and electric issues but those are being worked on. Mayor also gave an update on the FY 2025 audit, the auditors and the CPA's have been at the office, and it is moving along, hoping to have it completed by mid-April. Councilor Trujillo shared an issue that took place at the city park.
Public Comments	Judge Garcia gave an update on the court system and the training he attended. Tracy Master addressed the council regarding the corrected bill for Mr. Mike Anaya, asked to table the issue to be tabled further investigation, she also asked about the emails that get sent out and how that could be changed not to include all emails and how this could cause a security issue.
Consent Agenda	Councilor Snow made a motion to approve the consent agenda item #1 the regular meeting minutes for Feb. 11 ,2026 meeting and the accounts payable bill list, second by councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion passed.
Anaya Corrected billing issue	Mayor Anaya recused himself and turned the meeting over to Mayor ProTem Trujillo. The Clerk updated the governing body on a billing issue for Mr. Mike Anaya. She informed the governing body that Jeanette, the billing clerk, Jeff Tapia public works director, Councilor Spalding and herself, have investigated the billing error and contacted the meter company about the issue. The issue was a misreading of a digit on the meter, the reading did include a leak that was at the property, and the owner has been billed for the water leak. The clerk assured the governing body that the error was due to a misreading by the city and that it has been fully investigated by the clerk's office and the public works director Jeff Tapia. Mr. Anaya has already paid the corrected bill. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the corrected bill from \$26205.41 to \$ 1591.54, second by councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Mayor Presentations	Mayor Anaya, presented service awards to Mayor Todd Hart and Councilor Bobby Ortiz.
Bobby Ortiz-EMWT-Melody Ranch	Mr. Ortiz gave an update on the EMWT Water: They currently have purchased within the last year include Sunset acres subdivision and homestead estates. They were just recently approached by Melody ranch due to their current water issues. Mr. Ortiz presented the idea of the City of Moriarty supplying water to these subdivisions that are currently out of the city limits but would allow for a better system for everyone in the future and keeping the water in the area.
Item #4 Water presentation	This item was tabled until the April 8 th council meeting
Transportation Road Mgt	Mayor Anaya informed the governing body that the city is in need of a Transportation Mgt. Plan and there is grant funding to help get this complete. a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve and allow to apply for grant funding for this project, second by councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.
MRCOG	The clerk asked to get approval to move forward with MRCOG on grant assistance from the COG assist the city with grant administration. a. Councilor Snow made a motion to approve the clerk to move forward with this assistance, second by councilor Spalding, all present voted yes, motion carried.
	Mayor had a discussion on the 4 th of July and would like the city to start having celebrations like the past. Possibly have a street dance and other events that would be all day long.
Capital Outlay	The clerk gave an update on the capital outlay projects and grants
Administration Building Assessment	Mayor explained the need to procure an architect to do an assessment on the city hall building. He contacted an architect off the CES site because these are all state procured. They will do an assessment of the building using one of the current grants the city has. a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve procuring an architect, second by Councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Fire Chief Hart	a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve extending the contract 2301 for Dylans diesel for vehicle maintenance and inspections, second by councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried. b. Chief gave a department update
Resolution 25-26-17 Budget adjustments	a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the budget adjustments resolution # 25-26-17, second by councilor Spalding, roll call vote: Trujillo yes, Garcia yes, Snow yes and Spalding yes all voted yes, motion carried.
