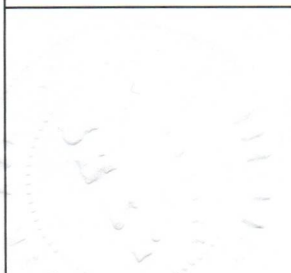
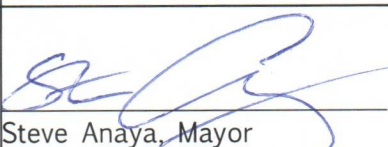
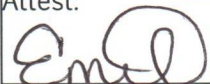

TIME, PLACE AND ATTENDANCE	The Moriarty City Council met at Regular Meeting, with the following members present: Mayor Steve Anaya, Robin Spalding, Kenny Snow, Kim Garcia. Jeremy Trujillo present
CALL TO ORDER	Mayor Steve Anaya called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.
AGENDA	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the agenda , second by Councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Governing Body Update	Mayor Anaya gave an update on the wastewater treatment grant application with the water trust board, and it moved to the next step. DOT filled in potholes in the right a way. There are still discussions on the rest of the potholes. Councilor Garcia wanted to thank everyone for their involvement for the easter egg hunt. She did have concerns about the restrooms and would like to see them repaired and useable for public use.
Public Comment	Jerri Pohl did thank Chief Hart for assuring the community about the water concerns. She also stated that she would like the city not to take action on the executive session due to the wording not being sufficient for her. Councilor Snow spoke about the Town of Edgewood's issue regarding their fire department coverage and how that might affect the city.

Transportation Mgmt. Plan- Resolution 25-26-18	Mayor Anaya presented the council with an application resolution for the NMDOT Transportation Fund for a Transportation Management Plan in the amount of \$ 120,000 with a 95% grant (\$114,000) and 5% match (\$ 6000) city match. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve resolution 25-26-18, second by Councilor Snow, a roll call was taken: Spalding yes, Snow yes, Trujillo yes, Garcia yes, motion carried.
Grissom Park/ Mtn. View Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Mayor Anaya presented ratification of a change order for \$ 2639.36 for the Grissom Park, Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the change order, second by Councilor Spalding, all present voted yes, and the motion carried. b. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the changes to the Grissom Park and Mountain View Cemetery of reducing the cemetery budget by \$ 106,400 and increasing the Grissom Park budget by \$ 92,445.27 this would include items that are already in the bid and scope of work, second by Councilor Spalding, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Studio Southwest Architects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the Proposal to approve the architectural/Engineering service for the city hall building in the amount of \$ 174,029 plus tax, Second by Councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion carried.

Civic Center Director	Emily, Clerk/ Treasurer requested the approval to hire Chris Alvarado @ \$ 23.00 for the position of the Civic Center Director. Councilor Garcia made motion to approve the hiring of Chris Alvarado for the civic center director, second by Councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Event Coordinator	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve contracting Roddy Gallegos at a\$ 2500 per month for the events coordinator, second by Councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Gains n Glory	Discussion about a 5k run for the 4 th of July was presented. Will be added to the next agenda for action.

Councilor Snow made a motion to approve the expenditure of Keiser sled training aide \$ 5665, second by Councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion carried. e. Councilor Trujillo made a motion to approve the expenditure of training aides for EMS \$ 6285.17, second by Councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion carried.

Councilor Trujillo made a motion to approve a pay increase for officer Smith from \$34.65 to \$36.82 for completing his firearm instructor, second by Councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion carried. c. Chief Urbina gave a department update.
