


	The Moriarty City Council met at Regular Meeting, with the following members present: Mayor Steve Anaya, Robin Spalding, Kenny Snow, Kim Garcia. Jeremy Trujillo present, Councilor Snow joined via teams
CALL TO ORDER	Mayor Steve Anaya called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.
AGENDA	Councilor Trujillo made a motion to approve the agenda , second by Councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Governing Body Update	Councilor Garcia wants to make sure that the public restrooms will be ready for the holiday events, states it is needed and should be a priority for Jeff and his crew. Mayor thanked everyone who attended the Memorial Day event at the Veterans monument. Thanked the Police Department for participating in the special Olympics run. Councilor Snow shared some complaints he received regarding the city park.
Public Comment	Ashely Williams shared her resignation letter.
Consent Agenda	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the consent agenda with some corrections to the draft for final copy, second by Councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried
Karen Alarid FY 2026-2027 Preliminary Budget	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Presented a preliminary budget for FY 26-27. There was discussion on the enterprise accounts and the deficits they are in, Councilor Snow recommended not taking the deficits into account for preliminary budget purposes and reevaluating them for rate increases later. He also stated that the current employees should be priority. Mayor stated they have three choices on the expenditure side revenues are ok. Councilor Snow recommended that in order to balance the budget, the one additional officer in police office will need to be put on hold and that will add approximately \$ 127,000 to the budget of that amount transportation cost will be increased. Councilor Snow made a motion to approve the FY 2026-27 Preliminary budget with the following : put the one police officer on hold until later in the year and to include the 2.5% C.O.L.A increase for employees and 3% increase to the employer portion of PERA for all employees except police and adding \$ 30,000 to transportation costs and add \$ 30,000 to contractual services for the cleaning contract for the city buildings, second by Councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Library- Natalie Bott	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Due to staffing library is requesting a temporary change in the hours of service. Hours will be Mon-Fri 8am-5pm with the exception of first week of June to accommodate the Summer Kick off hours will be Tues-Fri 9am 5-pm and Sat. 10am -3pm. Councilor Spalding made a motion to approve the temporary change of hours for the library, second by Councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.

Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the following budget adjustments: Acct 206 Decrease acct# 206-3003-5303 by \$5000, decrease acct #206-303-5599 by \$1100 decrease acct 206-3003-57050 by \$43.28, decrease acct 206-3003-54040 by \$ 2000, total decrease is \$8143.28 and increase acct 206-3003-56070 by \$ 8143.28, second by councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried. b. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the donation of a fire truck to Harding County and to allow the submission for approval letter to DFA, second by Councilor Spalding, all present voted yes, motion carried. c. Chief Hart gave a department update

Councilor Snow made a motion to approve the expense of \$ 14,027.72 to upfit the 2025 Ford explorer from LEPF 211-3001-58999, second by Councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion carried. c. Councilor Spalding made a motion to approve the expense of \$ 10,086.43 to upfit the 2018 Charger from LEPF 211-3001-58999, second by Councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion carried. d. Councilor Snow made a motion to approve the promotion of Office Jonathan Myrick

		to Sergeant and to increase his pay to \$40.00, second by Councilor Garcia, all present voted yes, motion carried. e. Chief Urbina gave his department update
