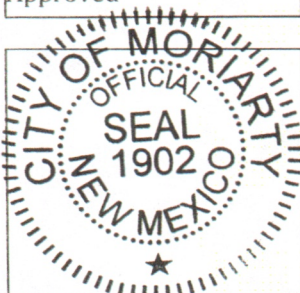

	The Moriarty City Council met at Regular Meeting, with the following members present: Mayor Steve Anaya, Robin Spalding, and Kim Garcia. Jeremy Trujillo all present, Councilor Snow is absent
CALL TO ORDER	Mayor Steve Anaya called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.
AGENDA	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the agenda with the request to remove item # 8, second by Councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Governing Body Update	d. Mayor announced the 4 th of July events with the parade starting at 10am and announced the city will have a float. Councilor Spalding asked if matters from departments heads could be added to the agenda, it was recommended they could speak during public comment or during their department head update.

Public Hearing	Mayor opened the Public Hearing for comments: the hearing is for Sierra Blanca Brewing to add wholesale sales to their liquor license. Susan Weber with Sierra Blanca addressed the public and governing body to explain that they are asking to expand their wholesale abilities to sell to any liquor establishments. Mayor asked if there were any other public comments with there being no other comments the a. public hearing was closed by Councilor Garcia making a motion to close the public hearing, second councilor Spalding a roll call vote was taken: Spalding yes, Garcia yes, and Trujillo yes, motion carried. b. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the Sierra Blanca Brewery wholesaler license, second by Councilor Spalding, a roll call was taken: Spalding yes, Garcia yes and Trujillo yes, motion carried.
Airport – Bob Hudson	a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the redirecting of expense from the crop duster to purchase a generator battery charger and fix wing replacement parts, second by councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Lodgers Tax	a. Hunter Salter gave an update on last year's bull bash event and requested funding for sponsorship for the 2026 Bull Bash. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the lodger's tax
Cleaning Contract	a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the quote from A&B cleaning in the amount of \$749.83 per month for the city building, airport and workforce connection buildings, second by councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Lease Agreement NM Workforce Bldg	a. Councilor Garcia made a motion to increase the building lease amount from \$836.92 to \$1100.00 per month, second by Councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Fire Department	a. Chief Anaya made a request to amend the FY 2028-2031 that was previously approved, requesting to add improvements to the Training facility it will be a phased project for a total of \$1,679,750.00. Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve amending the previously approved ICIP to include this project for the training facility improvements in the amount of \$1,679,750.00, second by Councilor Spalding, all present voted yes, motion carried. b. There was discussion on adding three lieutenants to the fire department, job descriptions were provided the estimated total would be approximately \$ 4000.00 to the budget not including benefits. Anaya gave a fire department update
