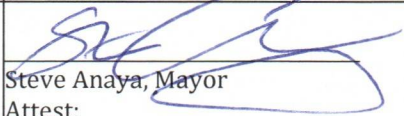
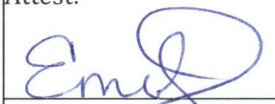




CITY OF MORIARTY

	The Moriarty City Council met at Regular Meeting, with the following members present: Mayor Steve Anaya, Robin Spalding, and Kim Garcia. Jeremy Trujillo and Kenny Snow are all present,
CALL TO ORDER	Mayor Steve Anaya called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.
AGENDA	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the agenda, second by councilor Snow, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Governing Body Update	Mayor and Councilor thanked everyone that participated and assisted with the 4 th of July festivities. Councilor Snow requested for the next meeting from planning zoning the ordinances for that department, he is concerned that the governing body has not seen or approved anything from them since his tenure. Councilor Spalding is wanted a further discussion on the city offices hours all returning to 8am –5pm Monday – Friday. She is requesting this be on an agenda soon.
Public Comment	Jess Lopez is requesting the use of the civic center on Jan 23, 2027, for their annual meeting, he was advised that this will be on the next meeting agenda for July 22, 2026. Calob, Kim and Ernest Ortiz, all spoke regarding the executive session on the agenda not sure what it was about but they are concerned about the Mars project by the county and were not sure if this had anything to do with it but wanted to express their concern to the governing body that this project is by their property.
Consent Agenda	Councilor Garcia made a motion to approve the consent agenda, second by councilor Trujillo, all present voted yes, motion carried.
Resolution 25-26-26 Final FY 2026-27 Budget	The final budget recommendations were presented to the governing body. Councilor Snow requested to have a special meeting on July 16, 2026, at 6pm. He is requesting that all data be complete and sent to the council by Monday July 13, 2026, so they can review all the changes. He would like current financial reports with that there was no action taken on this item.

Councilor Garcia made a motion to reconvene into regular session, second by councilor Spalding a roll call was taken: Spalding yes, Snow yes, Garcia yes and Trujillo yes, motion carried. Mayor announced no action was taken and only the item(s) that were listed were discussed.
