

The City of Moriarty City Hall will be reopening, however, it is encouraged for residents to continue observing the Governor's Public Health orders and recommendations in place to stop the spread of the virus.

Though residents can enter city offices to conduct business, the city still highly encourages that service be done via phone or online, and face masks will be encouraged for those who do visit City Hall in person. In-person city meetings will resume after June 1st, though virtual participation options for the public will remain available.

As far as city employees go, all, non-compromised, city staff may return to work on a normal schedule. However, remote work will be maintained on a discretionary basis, and high-risk individuals should stay home, if possible. Common areas and frequently touched surfaces will continue to be disinfected daily and employees will continue to have their temperatures checked and be required to wear masks when working in close proximity.

Appropriate personal protective equipment and safety restrictions will continue to be followed.

The Moriarty Municipal Court will be opening on June 10th, by appointment only.

The Moriarty Municipal Library will reopen June 2nd, with abbreviated hours: Monday through Friday. Senior Citizens can access early from 9:00 am to 10:30, and all other patrons from 11:00 am to 4:30. Common areas and frequently touched surfaces will continue to be disinfected daily, patrons will have their temperatures checked and face covering will be required.
